LETTER TO MEMBERS

October 14, 1980

It has been a long wait, probably for you, but definitely for me, to get this newsletter delivered to you. I hope that this delay or your patience gets a fair payoff.

First of all, I want to thank you for your support and giving me a chance to serve you by taking the ACFSTA office. Without exception, as one of our Chinese proverbs says: 新宫上行 三十巴火」 I have to try my three burning torches: clean up, shape up and set up our business operations.

Miss Angel Yang (楊安琪) and Dr. Hong-Ming Soo (蘇璃銘) both also from Ralston Purina and old crew of ACFSTA '79, have agreed to serve as our Secretary and Treasurer, respectively, for another term. Their assignments have gained unanimous approval from our Executive Committee and are no doubt valuable assets to ACFSTA '80.

To take the advantage of our staff's experience and in anticipating our potential future growth, we decided to undertake a big job. Internally we began to establish a complete, systematic and efficient system for keeping our business records, and externally we try to function as a first-class organization. This job may appear rather simple to you, but it has never been easy for us. Those who know how we handle our "segmented" (from year to year) office work will understand. If it were not for the fact that our ACFSTA has its head-quarters here at Ralston Purina for two consecutive years, we would have very little desire to do anything about it. It's just not a glamour thing to do, but we hope that you care.

Therefore, most of our staff's effort since last IFT meeting has been spent on doing the office chores. Thanks to two-thirds of our members who have returned the new membership information cards. Now we have a better record upon which to rely. If the number of our members doubles or triples within three to five years, the system will still be workable. Further on, there will be no big deal to have our system computerized! If you have not returned your card, we urge you to do so. Otherwise, we will have to assume that you are no longer interested in being part of us (see p.4 for further detail).

Once our record is straight, I will make sure that our future officers follow the system. We will publish our directory, distribute our newsletters and conduct our official election, etc. according to this record.

Currently, we still plan to have four issues of the ACFSTA newsletters. Being unable to delegate the editorial responsibility to another person, I will still take the main burden and work with our staffs here.

The next issues will be published at the end of December, March and May. You know that the newsletter belongs to you and is our only affordable bridge linking you and us. Please, let us hear from you. I have sent a special note to every regional correspondent of ACFSTA to ask for continuous supply of news materials. Please do not forget to keep us informed.

We are planning to include several feature articles or special topics in our future issues. Suggestions have been made in dealing with those which show common interest to all members, such as "What's new in the universities and industries," "Tips for Job Interview," etc. We certainly need your ideas and want to solicit your contributions.

It would be an oversight not to comment on our financial condition. However, from our Treasurer's report (p. 3), you do not need my help to see how we have grown financially. You are looking at a very healthy account. More membership dues are expected to be turned in for 1980-81. Please note that we did not print our directory as in the past at the end of 1979-80 when our records encountered maximum uncertainty. There was a budget leftover from the previous year and it will come in handy when we need it in December to publish a more reliable directory. My overall financial management policy is to spend our money as long as we know how to replenish it. It's a bargain for every member to pay dues and contribute additional money to our operation fund. I would not hesitate to ask you for your help, because you are the one who benefits.



Notes:

- (1) Membership dues received as of 9/30/79 totaled \$780.00 (ACFSTA Vol. 2, No. 1 report) and included a sum of \$338.00 paid by members for 1979-80. Many members were confused by our collecting practice as to which fiscal year their dues were remitted. In the past we tried to collect membership dues for the previous year during our annual banquet. Many members complied but assumed payment for the coming year. We had tried our best to clarify this incident and followed up those who did not remit their dues. As a result, we have reached an all-time high record of \$1,032.00 for 1979-80 dues. According to our by-laws, from now on we will ask you to pay your membership before December 31 of the same fiscal year.


