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# CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR CAFS PRESIDENT-ELECT

Dear CAFS members:

The 2024-2025 CAFS Nomination Committee is calling for the nominations (including self-nomination) for CAFS 2025-2026 President-Elect. The duties of the President-Elect, nomination process, and qualifications of the candidates for the President-Elect are stated in the following sections (7.4 and 9) of the CAFS Bylaws:

7.4. PRESIDENT-ELECT: The President-elect shall assist the President, formulate plans for his/her presidency including appointing Committee chairperson for each Committee for the next term, and succeed to the office of the President at the end of the Annual Meeting. The President-elect usually serves as the chairperson of the Annual Meeting Committee and performs the duties of the President in the President's absence.

#### 9. NOMINATION:

Nomination Committee shall solicit potential candidates from the membership in the Newsletter or through a special announcement before a final list is compiled. Any member may suggest names of candidates for the President-elect, Directors, Secretary, Treasurer, or other elected officers to the Nomination Committee by submitting a biographic sketch of each candidate along with a signed statement of the candidate that he/she is willing to hold office if elected.

**Qualification of candidates** for the President-elect shall include but not limited to: (1) at least three-year current Membership or Lifetime Membership in good standing, (2) served as an elected office of the society, and (3) good leadership qualification and administrative experience. Other candidates shall have at least one-year current Membership or Lifetime Membership in good standing show willingness to serve CAFS at the time of nomination. After reviewing each candidate's qualifications, the Nomination Committee shall prepare a slate of one to three candidates for each position with the ballot form, voting instructions, biographical sketches and nomination statements for the annual election at least two (2) months before the Annual Meeting.

*Nomination documents:* The nominator should submit a nomination letter, the current resume of the nominee, and two reference letters from current CAFS professional members to the Award Committee.

#### • CAFS Distinguished Service Award

*Purpose:* To recognize a professional member for his/her outstanding and sustained contribution to CAFS.

*Eligibility: Active CAFS members only*. The winner will receive a commemorative plaque and an invitation to the award ceremony at the CAFS annual banquet.

**Nomination documents:** The nominators should submit a nomination letter, the current resume of the nominee, and two reference letters from current CAFS professional members to the Award Committee.

#### Number of Awards per Year

Professional Achievement and Distinguished Service awards: one each. The awards will only be honored when qualified recipients are identified.

#### Selection Process

Upon receipt of all applications by the deadline, the Award Committee will review the applications and supporting documents. Each committee member will assign a numerical rating

to each candidate. Those candidates receiving the highest scores will be the winners. In case of a tie in a given category, the committee chair can call for a re-vote.

We are calling for students in CAFS to submit original abstracts for the 2024 CAFS Student Research Competition. The deadline for paper submission is **May 5, 2024**. Please send your abstract **in PDF format** as an email attachment to Zhenjiao Du (<u>zhenjiao@ksu.edu</u>). For detailed instructions, please refer to the attached guidelines.

We are thrilled to announce significant enhancements to this year's competition, including updated awarding criteria and simplified participation procedures. This year, we are proud to offer at most **11 prizes for students**, a notable increase from the four prizes awarded in previous years. This expansion aims to recognize and celebrate the dedication of students in the field of food science while fostering their career development. Additionally, in recognition of their participation, all students participating in this activity will **receive a certificate of participation**. The submission format of the abstract will be the same as the Technical Research Paper Abstract in IFT.

#### 2024 CAFS Student Research Competition Submission Guidelines

#### **Purpose:**

- 1. To foster and promote scientific research and scholarship among student members of CAFS in food science or related fields.
- 2. To acknowledge the excellence of research and presentations by undergraduates/graduate students.

#### **Criteria and Procedures:**

- 1. The competition is open to all **full-time students** enrolled in North America within the field of Food Science or related programs. Contestants can be undergraduates, graduate students, or in a transitional phase within their program. Post-doctoral fellows are ineligible. Contestants will be further categorized and evaluated based on their degree levels.
- Contestants must be CAFS student members or apply for CAFS student membership at the time of the competition. For information on becoming a CAFS student member, please visit <u>https://www.cafsnet.org/joincafs.htm</u> or reach out to Juan Gao (jg22cb@fsu.edu) or Zhengjiao Du (zhenjiao@ksu.edu).
- 3. Abstracts submitted for the competition must be from original research conducted primarily by the students and **have not been presented or published elsewhere**. Previously published studies will not be accepted for the competition.
- 4. Each contestant is permitted to submit only **one** paper.
- 5. The deadline for poster submission is May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024 at 11:59 pm Eastern Daylight Time (EDT).
- 6. The student must be the **primary author** (typically the first author) of the paper.
- 7. At most 11 finalists will be selected by May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024. In the second round, a Zoom meeting for oral presentations will be scheduled between June and July 2024. All finalists must briefly present their research and respond to questions from judges. An email notification will be sent

once the date and details are confirmed. Evaluation criteria will include the quality of the presentation, originality, research quality, writing, and the ability to address judges' inquiries.

#### Prizes:

The 2024 CAFS student research competition winners will be announced at the CAFS annual meeting/banquet. Each winner will receive a certificate and a monetary award.

- 1st prize: \$600 (1)
- 2nd prize: \$400 (1)
- 3rd prize: \$200 (1)
- Honorable Mention: \$100 (3 8)\* \* Depends on the total number of participants

#### Instructions for preparing competition abstracts:

- a. Each paper must be in PDF format. The file name should follow this format: "Contestant's first name + Contestant's last name-Abstract title.pdf". Please include your identity (Undergrad/Grad), your and your advisor's email addresses, as well as your affiliation in the body of the email. The email can be sent to <a href="mailto:zhenjiao@ksu.edu">zhenjiao@ksu.edu</a>.
- b. On the title page (first page), provide the title of the paper, the names of all authors and their affiliations, and the contact information (email) of the graduate student.
- c. Each paper must contain the following five components. Tables and graphs are optional but no more than 4 in total if presented. Abstracts must be **350 words or less**, including the introduction, methods, results, and significance (A two-sentence summary is excluded). (A template can be downloaded from the <u>Google Drive</u>).

- Introduction
- Methods
- Results/Discussion
- Significance

# 2023-2024 CAFS NEW LIFE-TIME MEMBER

Cangliang Shen (West Virginia University)

Dr. Cangliang Shen is the Professor/Extension Specialist at Davis College, Division of Animal & Nutritional Sciences and Family & Community Development, West Virginia University. Dr. Shen worked at IEH Consulting Groups (Research Associate), USDA-ARS (Postdoctoral Research Microbiologist), and Western Kentucky University (Assistant Professor) after obtaining his Ph.D. from Colorado State University. Dr. Shen is currently teaching General Microbiology lecture and labs, Living in a Microbiology World, Food Microbiology Lab, and Food Chemistry courses. Dr. Shen's research interest is in developing postharvest



sanitizing procedures for reducing food safety risks on poultry meat products and fresh produce. Dr. Shen has published 60 journal articles, 2 textbooks, and 3 book chapters, and secured USDA-NIFA grants over

\$3.6 million. Dr. Shen serves as the editorial board member of Food Control, Journal of Food Protection, and Food Protection Trends. Dr. Shen received the Outstanding Volunteer Award of Food Microbiology Division-Institute of Food Technologists (IFT) in 2018. He was the Chair of Food Microbiology Division-IFT in 2019-2020 and the Chair of Biotechnology Division-IFT in 2022-2023.

Quancai Sun (Florida State University)



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Dr. Quancai Sun, currently working as an assistant professor in the Department of Health, Nutrition, and Food Sciences at the Florida State University, specializing in the field of functional foods and nutrition. Prior to my current role, I completed my Ph.D. training with Dr. Yeonhwa Park in Umass Amherst and postdoctoral training with Dr. Guodong Zhang at the National University of Singapore. My expertise focuses on the mechanistic study of phytochemicals in the prevention of chronic diseases as well as food contaminants in the development of obesity, T2D, and colon inflammation. For this purpose, I use

interdisciplinary approaches from food biochemistry, molecular biology, and omics to study:

- 1. Phytochemicals and their beneficial influence on human health.
- 2. Dietary proteins/peptides and their beneficial influence on gut microbiota and colon health.
- 3. Food contaminants and their potential influence on gut microbiota, colon health, as well as obesity.

#### Zhipeng (Toby) Tao (Texas Woman's University)

Dr. Zhipeng (Toby) Tao joined the Department of Nutrition and Food Sciences as an Assistant Professor in January 2024 at Texas Woman's University (TWU). Before joining TWU, Toby worked as a postdoctoral research fellow for four years at Massachusetts General Hospital/Harvard Medical School. He received his Ph.D. degree in Molecular and Cellular Sciences from Virginia Tech in 2019.

Toby's overall research vision is to elucidate the role of lipid metabolism and mitochondrial function in cancer and metabolic diseases (diabetes and obesity) and design nutritional interventions and evidence-based target therapies.
